Important Safety Information

- Do not step on the sink or top plate.
- Do not drop heavy object on the sink or top plate.
- If it is damaged, stop using it and check for water leakage or damage.
- Please do not touch the damaged part as there is a risk of injury.

Notes on usage

- SILGRANIT is made of a delicate material, so please handle with care.
- Do not hit it with hard objects. It can damage the sink.
Also, be careful when handling glass and plates. Because the sink is made of hard material, it is easy to break the glass and dishes if you hit it.
- SILGRANIT is a very hard material with a hardness of 7 on the Mohs scale.
- Silgranit has a heat resistance temperature of 280° C.
Although the material is highly heat resistant, do not place hot pots or pans directly on it.
Also, do not pour boiling water or hot oil.
- If bleach adheres to the sink, it may cause discoloration.
Use a separate container to avoid direct contact with the sink.

Care instructions

- Do not use alkaline detergents or cleaners that dissolve clogged drains.
There is a risk of altering the surface of the SILGRANIT material.
- Do not use detergents containing abrasives such as cleansers.
The uneven surface of the sink may be scraped away, and the texture and luster may appear to have partially changed.
- The drain port is fixed by sandwiching the upper and lower drain parts with a hexagonal nut.
Please do not remove the hexagonal nut when cleaning. It may cause parts to fall off or water leakage.
