


## Draining

Turn left / right to open / close with the rotary switch.




Overflow

## How to remove the overflow plate

Press firmly on the left or right side of the plate with your fingers or tools. \*Be careful of the scratch Pinch the pop-up side and take out. Follow the steps when you return it



## Care and Maintenance

#### <Daily care>

Please clean kitchen sink regularly. Use a sponge with a soft side with a neutral detergent.

#### <Cleaning scaly marks >

If the sink is exposed to water for a long time, the lime scale may appear. Use a soft sponge with an acid-based detergent such as citric acid to dissolve the limestone. SILGRANIT is a strong material with high color fastness and chemical resistance, however, acidic detergents may cause corrosion of metal drainage fittings. Rinse thoroughly to wash the detergent. Wipe and dry with a microfiber cloth to prevent water stains caused by residual water.

#### <Cleaning metal stains>

SILGRANIT is a very hard material, however some cookware may scrape and stick to the sink surface. Use a sponge with a soft side with a little cooking oil and rub gently on the surface. And rub gently with a little detergent after that. Rinse throughly to wash the detergent. Wipe and dry with a microfiber cloth to prevent water stains caused by residual water.
